Dear Friends,

The most important news from Washington this week is actually about next week. Today, I was informed that we'll be voting next week on the Cut, Cap and Balance Act of 2011. This important bill, which I plan to support, would cut total spending by \$111 billion in FY 2012, cap total federal spending for the next 10 years and includes a Balanced Budget Amendment for the US Constitution. It represents a critical step forward in returning our nation to fiscal health, and I'll work to keep you informed as we debate it on Tuesday.

This week, as the negotiations on an increase of the debt ceiling continued between Congressional leaders and the President, the House passed the Energy, Water, and Related Agencies Appropriations bill for fiscal year 2012. I was proud to support this, as it cut spending back to Fiscal Year 2006 levels, cutting wasteful programs while maintaining responsible funding levels for important programs.
